For 50 years, Inland Valley Hope Partners has brought together individuals, faith communities, businesses and community groups with a mission to ensure the empowerment of people in need by providing food, shelter and supportive services. Each year the agency serves some 75,000 men, women, and children in 13 communities through the food and housing programs. The Housing Program, comprised of the Our House Temporary Housing, Rapid Re-Housing and Claremont Homeless Advocacy Program, helps quickly return homeless families and individuals to safe, stable housing and self-sufficiency while our food pantries and once per month food distributions (in Ontario, Pomona, Claremont, San Dimas, Upland and Chino) distribute about five days worth of food per person to low income families. That's a total of 900,000 meals per year to the hungry. Hope Partners also sponsors the Gleaning Hope Program, Hope Partners Garden at Amy's Farm and Farmer's Market in Pomona to ensure that those we serve have access to fresh, nutritious produce.
