Who We Are ...

Celebrating over 50 years of commitment, Inland Valley Hope Partners serves over 75,000 men, women and children each year through "Our House" family residential shelter; and Rapid Re-Housing; BETA, SOVA, Claremont, San Dimas and South Pomona food pantries; and the Pomona Farmers' Market throughout 13 communities including Chino, Chino Hills, Claremont, Diamond Bar, La Verne, Montclair, Mt. Baldy, Ontario, Pomona, Rancho Cucamonga, San Dimas, Upland,

Baldy, Ontario, Pomona, Rancho Cucamonga, San Dimas, Upland, and Walnut. The shelter houses five families for up to 90 days. The food pantries distribute five days worth of food per person to no and low income families. Clients may come once every 30 days. The Farmers Market operates every Saturday morning and accepts WIC and EBT cards. Begun in 1968 as the Pomona Council of Churches, today the non-profit is a collaboration of faith communities, businesses, community groups, and individuals who care about their neighbors.




Frank Hamilton at Hope Partners board retreat dinner in 2017.

Rev. Frank Hamilton twice served on the board of directors of Inland Valley Hope Partners, ending his second tenure in 2021. As the head pastor of First Christian Church of Ontario for 34 years, Rev. Frank had a strong interest in helping Ontario's homeless and lowincome households and was therefore very supportive of our Sova Center. He also served on Hope Partners' executive hiring committee to appoint our previous CEO, and his wise counsel in board meetings was always greatly appreciated.

Karl Hilgert has been a friend to Hope Partners since his arrival in Claremont. He previously served as the director of a homeless shelter and had a strong affinity for the work

we do at Hope Partners. He utilized his degree in social work to help supervise interns working in our housing programs for several years. Also, as a co-founder of the Claremont Homeless Advocacy Program (CHAP), Karl helped solidify our collaborative efforts with the group to serve the housing needs of homeless individuals in the city of Claremont. Karl also loved supporting our fundraising events, often walking in the Walk for the Hungry and Homeless and serving as the witness for our Hole-in-One contest at our annual Golf Classic.
